

ASO switch gives 'edge' to new DIY safety system

GERMANY manufacturer ASO Safety Solutions has developed a new refined 'Plug 'N' Sense' DIY system for the self-assembly of gate safety edges.

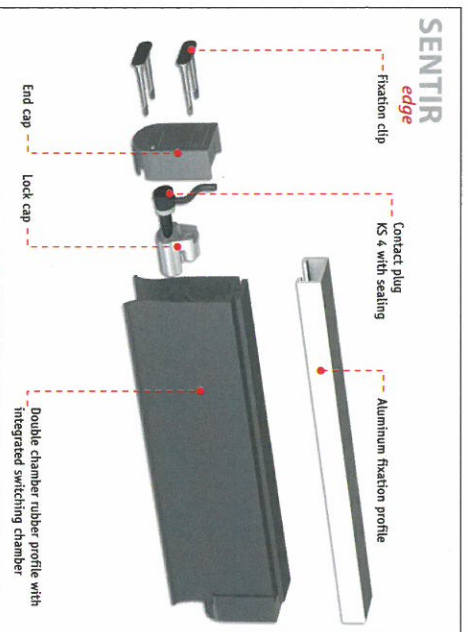
Incorporating a new plug and new faster switching profiles, the latest 'Plug 'N' Sense System' is claimed to be the simplest system now available in the UK market.

'This plug and its sealing guarantee IP65 protection together with the lock cap ensures that there is an accurate insertion of the plug into the switching chamber,' said Gooding. 'This and the new switching

profiles that have been designed into the latest 'Plug 'N' Sense System', make it one of the most advanced safety solutions of its kind and yet it can be assembled in minutes either during gate

production or on-site.' The system is delivered as a kit with step-by-step instructions included.

Research and development led to the launch of the new generation of 'SENTIR, safety contact edges last year and this is to continue.

'The aim is to have total compatibility of the whole of the 'Sentir' range with the new 'Plug 'N' Sense System' and further models will be available in the autumn. The new edges provide enhanced switching results and can be used on all gates,' he said.

'ASO Safety Solutions has a reputation for innovation in pursuit of the highest safety standards and with these latest products we again see that

they have achieved their goals.'

It was in 2011 that ASO set up its UK distribution centre at the new 13,500 sq ft EasyGate factory in Halesowen, as it looked to up its service levels to a growing customer base and to have greater stock availability in the UK.
